Ranthambore Tiger Sanctuary



Situated 12.1 kilometres from the Ranthambore National Park, the Sawai Madhopur Lodge (IHCL SEleQtions), is the only heritage hotel in Ranthambore. Since the original lodge was built over 80 years ago, thankfully, its character and allure hasn't changed.



The long pillared verandah with marbled floors is shared by the tenants of the rooms, offering a cozy space where folks can catch up and have tea/beer as they share stories and memories. It's especially dramatic if we get to watch an evening thunderstorm from this front-row seat!

The spacious rooms have rustic furnishings and custom lighting, giving them an elegant feel. Amenities like the flat-screen TV, tea and coffee-making facilities, and a personal safe ensure a comfortable stay. The opulent private bathrooms, with their large bathtubs and naturally-made toiletries are a treat, especially after dusty safari rides.

Enjoy the home-cooked feel of meals served at the Dining Room, and pool games and beer at the Tiger Bar, and warm bonfires at Neem Terrace. Swim in the lovely outdoor pool, with monkeys chattering in the overhead trees. With the greenery of lush gardens all around you, this is the ideal locale to feel your tensions melt away.




Rooms are air conditioned and have free wireless, but since we are in a remote area, wireless may be spotty.
